There are numerous exceptions to the public records laws which allow a public body to refuse to disclose public records. ORS 192.345, 192.355. Public bodies are not required to explain or answer questions about their public records, nor are they required to create public records where none exist. Public bodies are required to make available for inspection and copying, subject to any applicable exemptions, only those records that exist at the time of the request.
