Library Board Minutes

February 6th, 2024 meeting

Seaside Library Board of Directors

The meeting was called to order at 4:03 pm by Chair Tess Ratty.

Present were board members Tess Ratty, Eve Marx, Kathleen Teeple, and Meagan Hughes, as well as City of Seaside Council Liaison Tita Montero, Library Director Jennifer Reading and Assistant Library Director Josh Moorman. Board Member Cheryl Adamscheck was absent.

Approval of Minutes

The minutes from the January meeting were approved.

Reports

Josh Moorman, Assistant Library Director, reported on this month's events. Thank a Mail Carrier Storytime was held on Thursday 2/1 and the Youth Lego Club met on Saturday 2/3 where Jennifer filled in as staff supervisor. Upcoming teen events this month will be Charades on 2/7, a film screening of "The Sun is Also a Star" on 2/14, Painting Kawaii on Canvas on 2/21, and Cooking Bread-Pudding-In-A-Mug on 2/28. Teen Book Club will meet on 2/8 and talk about "Hummingbird" by Natalie Lloyd. The partnership with the high school library to hold teen events on campus is on hold for now because no high school staff is available. The rest of this month's Storytimes will be The Letter "H" on 2/8, Heart Day on 2/15, Pet Day on 2/22, and on 2/29 a police officer will be visiting. Adult focused events this month will be film screenings of "Sullivan's Travels" on 2/10 and "A Good Person" on 2/24, Board Game Night on 2/7, and this month's in person event will be Candace Pinger Smith discussing her family's proximity to the "The Peking Express" written by James Zimmerman on 2/22.

Jennifer Reading, Library Director, reported that the fundraising event being planned by the Library Foundation has been delayed but no new date has been set yet. Last month Jennifer presented to the budget committee and mentioned the need for creating a marketable position for a library staff member. Tita added that the deadline for budget approval is the end of May. Jennifer shared her experience presenting to a 9th grade Seaside civics class and shared that she will be headed back to the high school to present to a 12th grade class. She is currently in talks with History and Hops about sponsoring a speaker. History and Hops has been well attended and she hopes the library can gain some exposure by partnering with them. During last month's ice storm the library stayed open Friday and Saturday, the generator did kick on when the electricity went off, and the library closed on Sunday in an effort to keep staff safe and off the dangerous roads. The new Seaside Tourism Guide has been published and the library received a free advertising spot.

Old Business

The Oregon Library Association convention will be April 24th-27th. There are virtual options to attend sessions and a group learning opportunity with the other county boards is still on the table. The Public Library Association is also holding their bi-annual meeting this year and they will also have virtual options available. Jennifer received the building report from Ed Arden, the public works project manager. He states that the majority of the work needed can be performed by public works dependent upon their schedule, but that most of the work needs to be completed in dry conditions and due to our short dry season, it may be best to have the work performed by a subcontractor. Jennifer is working on a spreadsheet that will include the needed projects, the potential costs, the time needed to complete the project, and the frequency which the project needs to be done.

New Business

Tita Montero, City Council Liaison, shared that she has spoken with the League of Oregon Cities and proposed that Emily Neal (who presented to the library board in January) or a different speaker from OLA could present to the League of Oregon Cities at their meeting in October. Tita also shared that the city council toured the church next door to the library and they will be inquiring about the cost of demolition for both that building and the old school administration building. They are currently in talks with someone to do a building survey on both sites.

Tess mentioned that the PEO meeting this month will present the history of the library art committee.

There were no participants in public comment.

Next Meeting

The board will meet again at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 5th.






Seaside Library Public Library Director's Report March 5, 2024 Submitted by Jennifer Reading
