Minutes from April 2, 2024, meeting Seaside Library Board of Directors

The meeting was called to order at 4:02 p.m. by Tess Ratty

Present were board members Tess Ratty, Eve Marx, Kathleen Teeple, Cheryl Adamscheck and Meagan Hughes. Tita Montero, Seaside City Council liaison, also was present.

Approval of Minutes

The minutes from the March 5 meeting were approved.

Reports

Assistant Library Director

Josh Moorman, assistant library director, reported on upcoming events. The April Teen Programs include Manga, a Japanese style black and white graphic novel, on April 3; a Library Love craft day on April 10; outside sidewalk poetry on April 17; and board and card games on April 24. All events begin at 3 p.m. In addition, the Teen Book Club will meet at 10 a.m. on April 6. The book is "Thursday's Child," a novel about an orphan named Margaret. Author is Noel Streatfeild. In addition, the Youth Lego Club will meet at 11 a.m. April 13. Preschool Storytime themes are Carrot Day on April 4, Library Love on April 11, Dinosaur Day on April 18, and Planet Earth on April 24. All sessions begin at 10:30 a.m. Adult Programs include Board Game Night for Grownups at 5:30 p.m. April 3, screening of the film "3:10 to Yuma" starring Glenn Ford at 2 p.m. April 6, screening of "Free Guy" starring Ryan Reynolds at 2 p.m. April 13, and a performance by the Seaside Jazz Trio at 2 p.m. April 27.

Josh shared some attendance figures for March adult programs. Two attended Board Game Night, 16 came to hear Oregon Poet Laureate Anis Mojgani. Three viewed the film "The French Connection." Four watched "Queen of Katwe." Twenty came to hear Lego Masters semi-finalist Kelly Bartlett.

Library Director

Jennifer reported that the Library Foundation fundraiser will be 7 to 9 p.m. April 20 in the library. It will be a mystery night called "Caper at the Cost" and will involve the theft of the iconic oversized orange Adirondack chair in front of the tourism bureau. Cost to participate will be \$35 which includes hors d'oeuvres and beverages. The winning team will win two Adirondack chairs.

More routine maintenance has been scheduled, including carpet cleaning for late April. Seaside Public Works has been taking on some jobs, and the library really appreciates the help.

Jennifer will be attending the Oregon Library Association annual meeting in Salem at the end of April. She will share takeaways at the May board meeting.

We are looking forward to participating in the Clatsop Community College's Clatsop Works program and expect to get names of applicants by April 4. Interviews will be conducted during the month of April and we should have a finalist by May 15th.

Gearhart Chief of Police Joshua Gregory made a presentation to the library staff in early March. He discussed how different substances taken by people can present behaviorally. That will help staff navigate potentially challenging library patron situations.

The library art committee has discussed ways to promote art displays in the library. One possibility is to get on the Seaside Art Walk schedule. Jennifer met the Seaside High School and Middle School art teacher and found him open to the idea of a student art show in the library in May.

Jennifer will be recording a piece on April 9 on the KMUN Radio program called "An Adventure in History" with Mac Burns and Alana Kujala. She will make a presentation on "Youth and Education" to the Seaside Rotary club on May 2 and at the Cannon Beach Library on May 1.

Old Business

The library's new hours have been approved by the Seaside City Council. Beginning April 16, the library will be open 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Friday and Saturday, and 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. on Sunday. The library is closed on Monday.

As a learning opportunity, the Seaside library board may schedule a joint meeting with the boards of both the Astoria and Warrenton libraries

The next meeting of the library board is scheduled for 4 p.m. on Tuesday, May 7.
