Minutes from March 5, 2024, meeting

Seaside Library Board of Directors

The meeting was called to order at 4:02 p.m. by Tess Ratty

Present were board members Tess Ratty, Eve Marx, Kathleen Teeple, Cheryl Adamscheck and Meagan Hughes. Tita Montero, Seaside City Council liaison, was also present.

Approval of Minutes

The minutes from the February 6 meeting were approved.

Reports

Assistant Library Director

Josh Moorman, assistant library director, reported on upcoming events. The Teen programs include a Tech Take-Apart on March 6; the Teen Book Club (reading “The Hate You Give” by Angie Thomas on March 9; the Kind Eyes Collaborative Art Project on March 13; the Blind Taste Test on March 20; and a LEGO Design Challenge on March 27. All programs begin at 3 p.m. Preschool Storytimes, each with a different theme, include: Cheese on March 7, Pi Day on March 14, Forest Animals on March 21, and Chicks on March 28. All programs begin at 10:30 a.m. Adult programs include: Board Game Night for Grownups at 5:30 p.m. on March 6, Oregon Poet Laureate Anis Mojgani at 5:30 p.m. on March 7, screening the film “The French Connection” at 1 p.m. on March 9, screening the film “Queen of Katwe” at 1 p.m. March 23, and the Lego Masters Semi-Finalist Kelly Bartlet from Wilsonville at 2 p.m. March 30.

In addition, a LEGO Design Challenge for Grades K to 5 will be at 10 a.m. March 27 and a Youth Lego Club gathering will be at 11 a.m. March 16. A Teen Reading Challenge is planned for the whole month of March.

Josh shared some attendance figures for February adult programs. Fourteen attended Board Game Night, 6 attended the screening of “Sullivan’s Travels,” 19 came to hear Candace Pinger Smith on “The Peking Express and the Lincheng Outrage,” and 3 attended the screening of the film “A Good Person.”

The color pencil work of Cathy Stearns is now on display in the library.

Library Director

Jennifer report that the Library Foundation fund raiser will be April 20 in the library. It will be a mystery night called “Caper at the Cost” and will involve an oversized orange Adirondack chair.

More routine maintenance has been scheduled, including carpet cleaning, window cleaning and power washing of the building and the sidewalks.

The Reading Outreach Clatsop County report showed the library was awarded more than in the past from United Way of Clatsop County

Volunteer Jenny Gray has been helping with the Archives project.

We are submitting a grant application for a paid summer teen intern through the State Library of Oregon. The intern, found through Clatsop Community College's Clatsop Works program, will work 25 hours a week this coming summer. This is a pilot program for us.

We are recording 30 second ads for play on the radio station 94.9 The Bridge. We are reaching out to KMUN radio about doing something similar there.

Jennifer will be presenting an annual report to the Seaside City Council on May 13, which is the one-year anniversary of her employment here.

Old Business

Jennifer reported there are not going to be a lot of options to attend the Oregon Library Convention virtually. The conference is scheduled for April 24-27 in Salem

The library may sponsor a speaker for the Seaside Museum's History and Hops program. We plan to co-host a speaker in September and then co-hosting programs through May.

New Business

We are considering changing the library's evening hours. On Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, the hours would be 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Saturday hours would be 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Sunday hours would be 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.

The board was in favor of instituting this change.

Next Meeting

The next meeting of the library board is scheduled for 4 p.m. on Tuesday, April 2.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:50 p.m.




