Over the 2022 holiday season The Seaside Police Department (SPD) partnered with the U.S. Department of Transportation's National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) in an effort to make the roads in the community safer by taking impaired drivers off the roads. SPD Officers are dedicated to protecting the lives of the community members as well as those who visit and vacation here. Between the dates of December 15<sup>th</sup> - January 1<sup>st</sup> several Officers worked extra shifts with a focus on doing just that.

During this time, Officers conducted extra traffic stops. Officers enforced moving violations, lighting violations, driver's license suspensions and checked for any impairment while contacting the drivers of the vehicles. Lower-level violations were met with verbal warnings but citations were issued to non-valid and uninsured drivers.
