

SEASIDE TSUNAMI EVACUATION MAP

1 If you feel an earthquake

Drop, cover and hold. After the earthquake, don't wait for an official warning, head immediately **ON FOOT** out of the tsunami inundation zone. (It is estimated you'll have 20 minutes to reach higher ground.)

2 Where to go?

Locate which zone you're in on the map, and follow that evacuation route to the designated assembly area. (Note: Some of the bridges highlighted on the map may be difficult to cross after an earthquake, but these are the recommended routes at this time.)

3 Stay in the assembly area

Remain in the assembly area until you're instructed otherwise. Aftershocks and tsunami waves are expected to continue for hours after the initial event.
